# Christie Roadie 4K45 projectors light up Gala Performance at Grand Bao'en Temple

The city of Nanjing in China's Jiangsu Province has been known for its fascinating night lights since ancient times. These nighttime scenes were so impressive that even the literati were deeply enchanted by what they saw as they cruised down the Qinhuai River. This had been the source of inspiration for numerous classic poems and precious works of art. The brightly-lit Glazed Pagoda of Grand Bao'en Temple, which resembles a "fiery dragon flame meandering dozens of miles", is also acclaimed as one the most illustrious buildings in China's architectural history.

In an effort to revitalize the fascinating night lights and evoke the nocturnal beauty of Nanjing, the municipal government collaborated with celebrated director and producer Shuaiyuan Mei to create a large-scale cultural feast known as "The Grand Bao'en Temple Gala Performance" at the

Audiences were presented with the legendary lives of Ming Dynasty's Emperor Yongle, Chinese Buddhist monk Master Xuanzang and Shakyamuni Buddha to

The live performances had been staged with mountains and rivers as the backdrops. Created by the innovative team that pioneered the production of realistic backdrops of mountains and rivers in China, the gala performance was two years in the making, and was touted as the first large-scale historical performance in the country to be staged in a museum setting. The Christie® Roadie 4K45 projector, the industry's brightest lamp-illuminated projector built for the most rigorous Pro AV requirements, was the ideal

candidate to illuminate the Grand Bao'en Temple with a splash of rich and bright colors.


To underscore the significance of preserving Buddhist relics in the underground levels of the temple during ancient times, visual engineering service provider Digital Tiger Imageworks decided to extend the scope of performances to sub-levels as well. This led to the construction of a multi-level stage using a steel-structured lifting system. During the performance, a variety of visuals were projected on two movable Buddhist niche walls. Thanks to the innovative stage lighting system and projection mapping effects, audiences had the illusion that the Glazed Pagoda of Grand Bao'en Temple was floating

in the air. At other times, they were awed by scenes of moonlight cast on its façade, and images of galloping horses filling the pagoda with astonishing lighting effects. The night lights of Nanjing were finally brought to life again in the most spectacular manner!

The size of the projection area of the two-sided Buddhist niche walls onstage measured 41.8 meters by 10.6 meters when fully opened, and measured 33.8 meters by 10.6 meters when closed. To ensure optimal projection effect of images, two Christie Roadie 4K45s were used to display the visuals on these structures located on the left and right sides of the stage.

Boasting 45,000 lumens, 4K resolution and packed with value for live events and location-based entertainment, the Christie Roadie 4K45 projector is built for the most rigorous Pro AV requirements. With built-in Christie TruLife<sup>TM</sup> electronics for excellent color reproduction and image processing, as well as integrated warping and blending capabilities for world-class projection mapping applications, the Roadie 4K45 can bring buildings and monuments to life with projection mapped content, inspire crowds with moving images, reproduce photo-real visual content on almost any surface imaginable.
