Christie IMB-S2 Default 3D Setting Files

Christie IMB-S2	Internal and External Customers

Solaria Main Software v3.1.1 includes three default 3D files that control the behavior of 3D content on the Integrated Cinema Processor (ICP). Christie IMB-S2 firmware v1.1.0 uses the default 3D files to quickly adjust the 3D settings of the ICP to different frame rates. This table lists the default 3D files and the type of high frame rate (HFR) content each file is associated with:

3D File Name	Description	Frame Rate Range
3D24.3D	3D settings for 24 fps/eye 3D content	23 fps/eye – 30 fps/eye
3D48.3D	3D settings for 48 fps/eye 3D content	31 fps/eye – 50 fps/eye
3D60.3D	3D settings for 60 fps/eye 3D content	51 fps/eye – 60 fps/eye

If you have installed a Christie IMB-S2 with Christie IMB-S2 firmware version 1.1.0 and 3D files are on the ICP, the ICP 3D settings are controlled by the default 3D files and not the 3D settings specified on the **3D Control** page of the **Channel Setup** screen of the touch panel controller (TPC).

You cannot modify the default 3D files on Solaria Main Software v3.1.1. However, you will be able to edit the default 3D files on Solaria Main Software v4.0 and later.

If you are not showing HFR content, the default 3D files are not required.



Resolution

HFR Playback Required?	Resolution
No	Install the 88.3.1.1 hotfix to remove the default 3D files from the ICP. When you remove the 3D files, the 3D settings are determined by the information on the 3D Control page of the Channel Setup screen of the TPC. When you install the hotfix, the Solaria Main Software version does not change.
Yes	Create 3D files that match your system configuration and then upload the files to the ICP. For instructions on creating 3D files and uploading them to the ICP, contact Christie technical support and request a copy of <i>Playing High Frame Rate Content on the Christie IMB-S2</i> .
